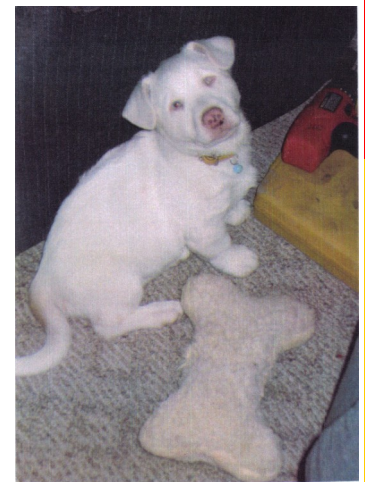
“Thank you!!! Thank you!!! Thank you!!! Words can’t express the gratitude my family and I have for this organization. You have helped us tremendously by
